A conceptual review on krimiroga in ayurveda

Abstract

The Ayurveda combines the Sanskrit words Ayu (life) and Veda (science or knowledge) thus Ayurveda means science of life. Ayurveda is a traditional system of medicine having emergence a thousand year ago. Since that ancient time Ayurvedic Acharyas were well known by existence of Krimis, and they have mentioned it in their various literatures regarding its Nidana (causes), Sankhya (different number), Naamkarana (terminology), Swarupa (appearance), Lakshana (symptoms), Sthana (finding area) Chikitsa Vyavastha (management), Yoga (Kriminasaka formulation). Even in the modern era Krimi has been considered a life-threatening issue as it causes illness in children and adult human beings having numbers of local to systemic manifestations such as Kandu, Kotha, Pidika, Shoola, Agnimandhya, Panduta, Vishthambhi, Balanasa, Lalasarava, Aruchi, Hridayaroga, and Atisara. In this review, an article effort has been made to elaborate the concept of Krimi chronologically from different Ayurvedic treatises and also to detailed the different perspective regarding its management as per traditional system of medicine.

Introduction

Krimiroga stand its urgency in Ayurvedic system of tradition medicine from ages ago. Ancient proficient Acharyas were adequately trained regarding its management and has elaborated its concepts profoundly. As per Shabdakalpdruma Krimi is delineated as “*Bhrame Samprasaraṇe Cha*” that meant to moves by the legs^[1]. Later in Samhita period there are numerous of concepts regarding Krimi including different perspective of its Nidana, Sankhya, Naamkarana, Swarupa, Lakshana, Sthana Chikitsa Vyavastha and Kriminasaka Yoga.

As well as the management of Krimis were sufficiently explained by principles of treatment as Apakarshana, Prakriti Vighatana, and Nidana Parivarjana which were applied for Krimis^[2]. The clinical conditions aroused because of the Krimi manifestation in children to adult human beings consist of the disease and disorder like skin ailments, GIT ailments, anemia etc. Now days because of several side effects of modern medicines demands of herbal medication was raised. As given concepts in Ayurvedic Samhitas regarding management of Krimi, there is adequate clarification of the basic principles needed for it also the various research works have been done on herbal, mineral and herbo-mineral drug preparations mentioned in Samhita that again revalidated the potency of the different Kriminasaka Yoga employed for the treatment aspects of the various Krimiroga.
